Reflections for Sunday's Readings

Reading I: Acts 4: 8-12: Peter's first discourse is more like an "apologia" than a sermon. In it, Peter answers the Sanhedrin's question directly.

Reading II: 1 John 3: 1-2: By way of the Paschal mystery, we have truly become the children of God.

The Gospel: John 10: 11-18: In this section, "good" really means "noble" or "ideal", and not just "good at" something or other. Unlike bad shepherds, who allow the sheep to be eaten by wolves, Jesus lays down His life for His sheep.

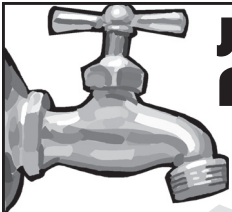

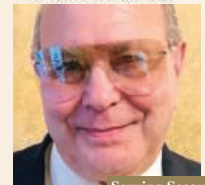
